#### Doug Woodring - Veterans Service Officer (VSO) View

Mental well being is as important, if not more so, as our physical well-being...you can't have one without the other. Veterans In crisis is an epidemic. No one should ever be afraid or ashamed to reach out for help. It is also our duty to conduct regular buddy checks on our fellow servicemen and women and their families. If you're a Veteran in crisis or concerned about one, you can reach a caring, trained responder, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

#### When you call the Veterans Crisis Line (veteranscrisisline.net), here is what you can expect...

- A qualified responder will answer your call, ready to listen and help.
- The responder will ask a few questions, such as whether you or the Veteran you're concerned about may be in immediate danger or at risk for suicide.
- The conversation is free and confidential. You decide how much info you want to share.
- Support doesn't end with your conversation. Our responders can connect you with the resources you need.

#### You don't have to be enrolled in VA benefits or health care to connect.

Last year, nearly 9000 Veterans in our area faced a suicidal crisis. Thanks to the VA, they received life saving care. For every life saved, there are hundreds of loved ones who are spared the pain of a loss. Let's ensure every Veteran knows there's help available.

Together, we can be there for those who have served us. Thank you for your service and contact me if you need additional info. The link in the above also has online resources such as assessments and warning signs for those in crisis.


