Here are a few topics I thought would be of interest to Post Members.

<u>File a Supplemental Claim</u>—If VA denied your disability claim in the past, but now considers your condition presumptive, you are encouraged to file a supplemental claim. This will allow VA to re-adjudicate your claim when presented with new evidence or policy. <u>Learn how to file a supplemental claim today. (https://news.va.gov/decision-reviews/supplemental-claim/).</u>

<u>Get screened for breast cancer</u>—October was breast cancer awareness month, a great reminder to get screened. VA healthcare gives eligible Veterans access to <u>comprehensive women's care services</u>. (https://news.va.gov/104765/woman-veteran-recommends-vahealth-care-safe-space/), including breast cancer screenings and care.

<u>Decision Letter Tool</u>—Did you know you can access your VA notices and claims development letters on VA.gov? You no longer have to wait for mailed copies or request reprints from VA. By logging in using your **VA.gov (https://www.va.gov/)** login info you can view your documents.

Cybersecurity Awareness—As technology advances, scammers are becoming smarter in their attacks. VA is actively working to identify growing fraud threats and trends. We are committed to **protecting Veterans** benefits against fraudulent activity and raising awareness of the various cyber scams. 
Good Day Fellow Riders and Legionnaires!
