#### Doug Woodring - Veterans Service Officer (VSO)



**PACT Act is 2 years old!** The Sergeant First Class Health Robinson Honoring our Promise to Address Comprehensive Toxins (PACT) Act is now 2 years old. This law has been the most significant expansion of benefits and

health care for toxic exposed Veterans and their survivors in over 30 years. To reach this milestone, VA has processed more than 2 million claims in 2024—another <u>all-time record</u>, on pace to surpass last year's record by more than 27%. VA encourages all Veterans, family members, caregivers, and survivors to <u>learn more about VA</u> and apply for their world-class <u>health</u> <u>care</u> and <u>earned benefits</u> today.

**Related to the above...VA Burn Pit Registry Redesign Auto Enrolls Participants, Simplifies Requirements.** The Department of Veterans Affairs is advancing efforts to address issues associated with military-related toxic exposure by launching a redesigned Airborne Hazards and Open Burn Pit Registry. Veterans and service members who served in military campaigns or theater of operations in certain areas of the world are automatically registered, based on their DoD records of service, but they can opt out of participation.

**Are you in need of a guide or service dog?** VA supports guide and service dogs for approved Veterans by referring them to accredited agencies. There should be no charge for the dog or associated training, and VA covers the costs of the veterinary care and equipment (e.g. harness and/or backpack) required for the dog.




#### Hello from the SAL


